

**NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 152CF(6) OF THE  
TRADE PRACTICES ACT 1974 (CTH)**

Pursuant to section 152CF(6) of the *Trade Practices Act 1974 (Cth)* (the "Act") the Australian Competition Tribunal hereby extends the six month period referred to in section 152CF(5) of the Act for making a decision on the review of the decision of the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission in this matter by three months up to the end of 14 June 2007.

The Tribunal has been, and will be, unable to make a decision on the review in this matter within the period of six months after the Tribunal received the application for review (14 September 2006) because of the time required for the parties to comply with the Tribunal's directions and prepare for the hearing, the time required for the hearing and the time required for the Tribunal to consider the matter and prepare its decision on the review.
