

AUSTRALIAN COMPETITION TRIBUNAL

PRACTICE DIRECTION No 4

Filing with the Tribunal

1. A party (other than the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (“the Commission”)) who wishes to file a document with the Tribunal must file:
 - (a) the original and six (6) hard copies of the document; and
 - (b) one (1) electronic copy of the document – the electronic copy must be provided in pdf format on a CD-Rom with each electronic document clearly marked and, if more than one document is filed, an electronic index of all documents contained on the CD-Rom.


2. Where the document is the initiating document, the application and accompanying documents may be filed by:
 - (a) presenting them to any Registry of the Tribunal;
 - (b) sending them by post to the Registry of the Tribunal at Melbourne, Level 7, 305 William Street, Melbourne, Victoria, 3000 or Sydney, Level 16, Law Courts Building, Queens Square, Sydney, NSW, 2000.

Only initiating documents may be filed by post, all other documents must be filed at any Registry of the Tribunal.

3. A document that is not an initiating document may be filed by presenting the document and the CD-Rom to any Registry of the Tribunal.

4. The Commission may file a document with the Tribunal by sending it to the Tribunal electronically in pdf.format and, if subsequently requested by the Tribunal, shall deliver to the Melbourne or Sydney Registry of the Tribunal hard copies (the number as specified by the Tribunal) of such document.

5. A party wishing to file a document in respect of which confidentiality is claimed in whole or in part should refer to *Practice Direction No 3 – Confidential Information* – before filing the document.
