I am responding to the draft determination regarding Honeysuckle Health's application to introduce what appears to be managed medial care into Australia. This determination does not take note of the serious effects on patient care if this is permitted but only of the effect on competition.

I object to 'managed care' and group negotiations by one company on behalf of our health funds. This is effectively a multi-billion dollar American company merging with an Australian health insurer to purchase health services from the private sector.

This model has clearly failed in the United States where the choice of doctor and treatment options are dictated by companies for commercial reasons. This would remove the right of the Australian public to choose who and where they receive care. It would be hugely detrimental to patients and clinicians.
