THE TRIBUNAL DIRECTS THAT:

1. The time for the filing and service of the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission's submissions be extended from 4pm on Tuesday 23 November 2021 to 4pm on Friday 26 November 2021.
2. Due to the procedures implemented by the Federal Court of Australia in response to the COVID-19 pandemic which include restricting parties, legal practitioners and members of the public from attending hearings at the Commonwealth Law Courts, Melbourne in person, pursuant to s 106(2)(a) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth)*:
 - (a) the hearing of the interlocutory application of Mr Robert Milliner filed on 6 October 2021 (**Interlocutory Application**) which is scheduled for 6 December 2021 will be conducted by way of video link using Microsoft Teams;
 - (b) instructions to enable members of the public to attend the hearing by video link are published on the websites of the Australian Competition Tribunal and the Federal Court of Australia; and
 - (c) the hearing will continue notwithstanding the inability of members of the public to be present in person.

3. In the hearing of the Interlocutory Application:

- (a) the legal representatives of the parties be permitted to deliver oral submissions by way of video link;
- (b) unless the Tribunal otherwise directs, no person may make any video or audio recording or photography of the hearing or any part of it, provided that nothing in these directions shall prevent any person, based on what he or she has seen or heard during the hearing, making his or her own notes or written record of the hearing or publishing a fair report of the hearing; and
- (c) unless the Tribunal otherwise directs, no person, being a member of the public, who is observing the hearing by accessing any video or audio link or other means, may participate in, or interrupt, the hearing.
